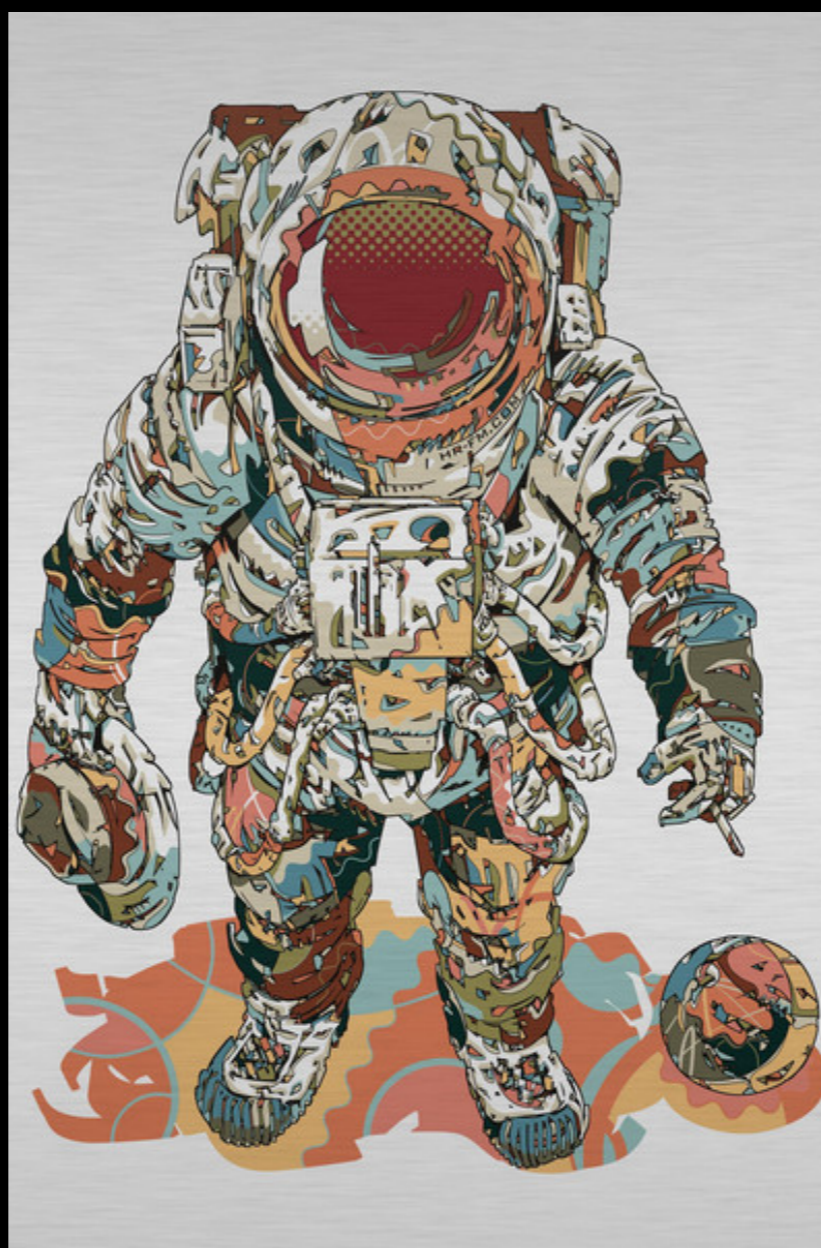
Windswept Live Oak Tree and Rising Full Moon at Night
